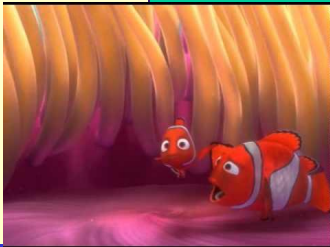
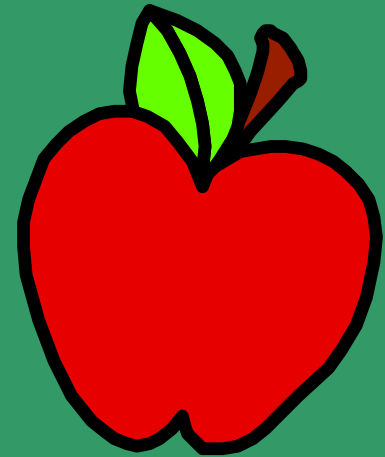

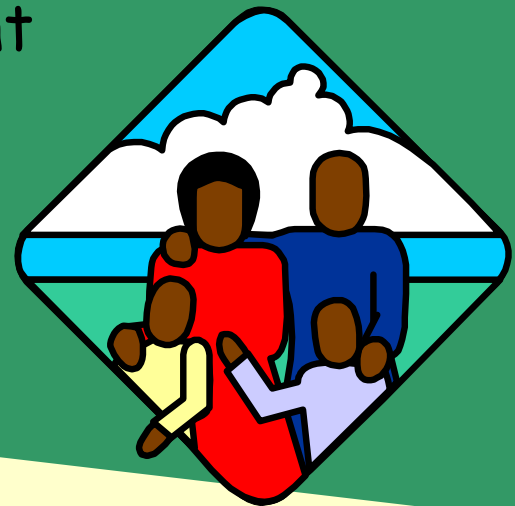
Student Expectations

- Homework should be turned in each morning
- Behavior in class should help create a positive learning environment
- Class work needs to be done neatly and to the best of your ability



Parent Expectations

- Homework- Check and sign your child's homework and planner each night
- Communicate regularly with teacher via conferences, planner, e-mail.
- Please make attendance a priority- It is important that your child is here each day and on time.



Teacher Expectations

- Daily Communication via assignment book, phone calls, e-mails, personal contact

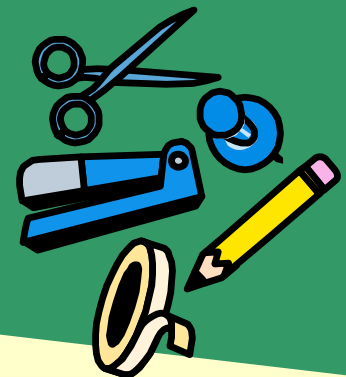


Discipline Procedures

- We will be using the colored card system to encourage positive behavior
- **Green card**-start with this each day-making good choices, positive reinforcement
- **Yellow**-warning to slow down and think about your behavior-5-10 min. of recess
- **Red**-stop misbehavior-no recess
- **Blue**-Call parents or note home
- **PINK**- Exceptional Behavior-positive reinforcement

Homework

- **Spelling**-Weekly word lists will be sent home every Friday in newsletter(see note: Spelling City)
- Test over words on Friday
- **Read** library books (library Tues./Fri.)
- **Math**-Each night there will be
 - 1 or 2 worksheets, excluding Friday's
 - fact sheet
 - practice review sheet
 - each sheet should be checked by parent or guardian



Writing

- . We use the Step Up To Writing Curriculum
- . We will be working our way to writing organized paragraphs including a topic sentence, 2 main ideas, 2 detail sentences, and a conclusion sentence.
- . Writing assessments will be in the fall and spring.

- Contagious disease
- If your child is on an antibiotic the medicine should be taken 24 hours before returning
- Vomitting or diarrhea
- Drainage from eyes
